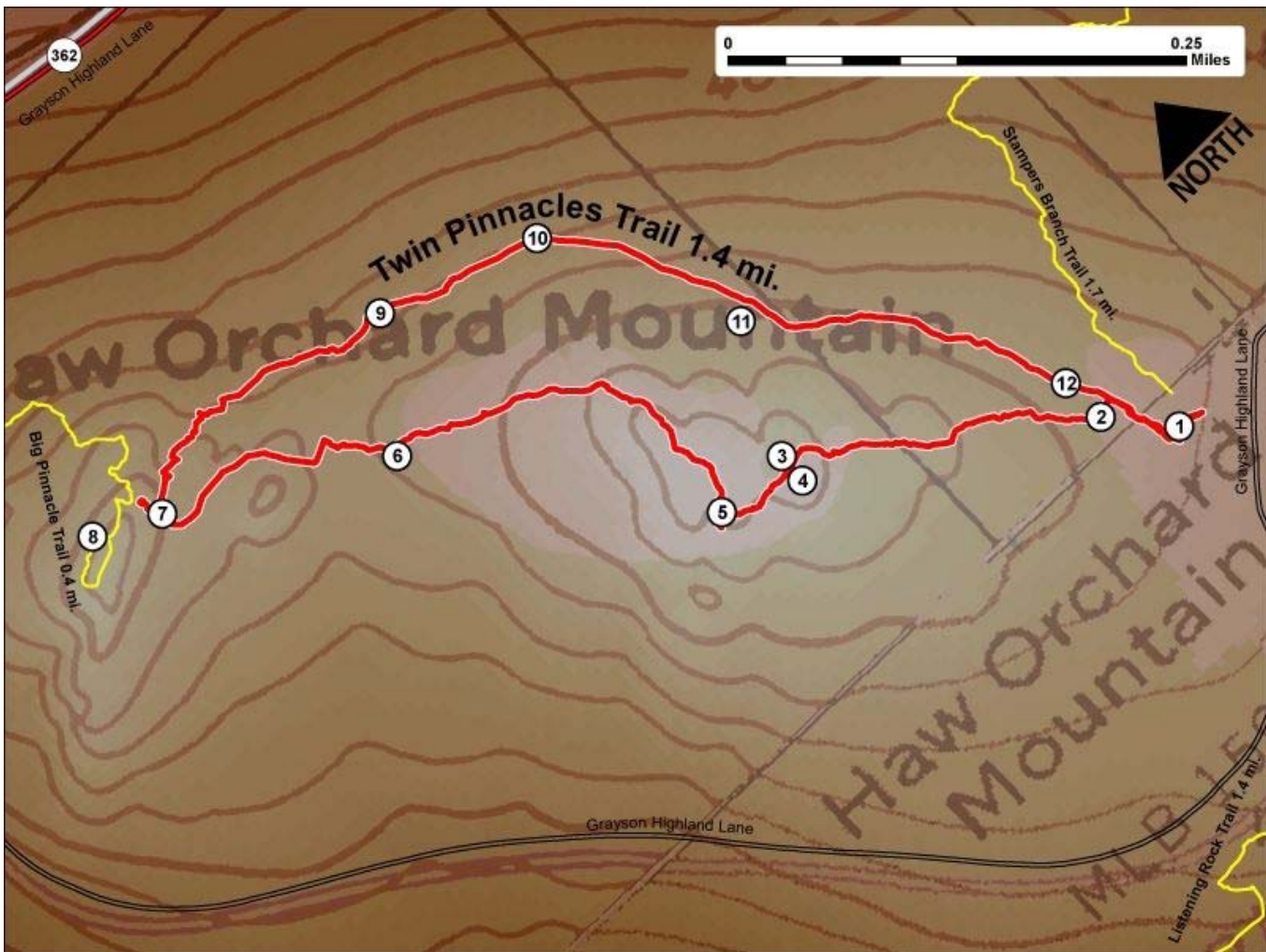

1. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.488, Lon. -81° 30.062
Twin Pinnacles Trailhead near Visitor Center – Elev. 4875'
2. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.52, Lon. -81° 30.088
Beginning of Twin Pinnacles Loop – West Branch leads to overlooks and twin summits of 5084 foot Haw Orchard Mtn.
3. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.607, Lon. -81° 30.245
Trail surface changes to earth and rock – shelter is nearby
4. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.602, Lon. -81° 30.246
Shelter
5. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.607, Lon. -81° 30.293
Summit of Pinnacle #1 – Trail is difficult and hikers are advised to use caution – Elev. 5084'
6. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.732, Lon. -81° 30.41
Transition from bald area to wooded area
7. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.788, Lon. -81° 30.534
Intersection with Big Pinnacle Trail and East Branch of Twin Pinnacles Trail – Elev. 4756'
8. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.803, Lon. -81° 30.573
On Big Pinnacle Loop Trail – Summit of Pinnacle #2 – Elev. 5069' with view of Mt. Rogers
9. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.787, Lon. -81° 30.36
On East Branch of Twin Pinnacles Loop
10. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.762, Lon. -81° 30.262
On East Branch of Twin Pinnacles Loop at halfway point
11. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.667, Lon. -81° 30.208
Shelter on East Branch of Twin Pinnacles Loop – Elev. 4930'
12. GPS: Lat. 36° 37.538, Lon. -81° 30.095
Approaching East end of Twin Pinnacles Loop

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
