1. GPS: Lat. 36° 47.107, Lon. -80° 56.11
MP 37.3: First put into service in 1912, Appalachian Power's Byllesby Dam underwent repairs during 2006. The dam hasn't changed much since it was first constructed, however the surrounding area has become one of Virginia's greatest treasures, in part due to the cooperation of companies such as Appalachian Power and Norfolk Southern, who both helped make recreation along the New River possible.
 2. GPS: Lat. 36° 47.708, Lon. -80° 55.485
Trail crosses Buck Dam Rd.
 3. GPS: Lat. 36° 48.298, Lon. -80° 55.884
MP 34.7: Appalachian Power Company's Buck Dam. These photos were both taken below Buck Dam which is located a little over two miles down the New River from Byllesby Dam or three miles above Ivanhoe Depot. Although AEP rebuilt this dam in the past few years, it looks about the same today as when it was first completed. The mountain in the background is Stoots's Mountain. Notice how the timbering activities of the past have been replaced by new growth forest.
 4. GPS: Lat. 36° 48.301, Lon. -80° 55.897
Buck Dam Parking Area: From SR 94 in western corner of Carroll County, take SR 602 east about 3 miles to river. Take SR 737 north to Buck Dam.
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
